PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the Governor's Interagency Alternative Fuels Working Group is committed to raising public awareness of biofuels (E85 and B20) as a practical alternative to petroleum-based vehicle fuels; and

WHEREAS, by establishing retail biofuel stations through a Biofuel Green Island Corridor Network along our interstates and major highways we will make biofuels more commercially available to all Tennesseans; and

WHEREAS, to complement and promote these ongoing efforts the state has launched BioTenn, a statewide public education and outreach campaign with the goal of increasing citizen awareness and understanding of biofuels in Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, by increasing the availability and use of biofuels, we will help protect public health by reducing vehicle emissions of harmful air pollutants, provide opportunities for rural economic development and reduce our dependence on petroleum.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Phil Bredesen, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby proclaim the 28th day of June, 2007, as


BIOFUELS DAY
